

Induction Programme for January 2021 Admissions

"Welcome to the IGNOU Family"

Amid the Covid situation in the country, IGNOU Regional Centre Port Blair is not able to organize the induction programme for the newly admitted learners who have taken admissions in January 2021 in various programmes in a face to face manner. Therefore, an online induction programme is being organized with the help of this power point presentation.

This PPT will give you all an idea on the open and distance learning process in IGNOU as well as to how to proceed further with your studies in IGNOU

In IGNOU everyone who have taken admissions are called as "Learners" and the teachers who teach them are called as "Academic Counsellors".

Teaching (both theory and practical) is both face to face as well as online. Theory classes are not compulsory to attend whereas practicals/projects/field practicum/ECP etc are compulsory

Learners requiring theory classes are required to contact their respective study centres along with the student ID card. Each Programme (B.Sc, B.A etc) consists of several courses.

All the learners are required to contact their respective study centres frequently for continuing with their programmes successfully

Admissions in IGNOU are carried out twice in a year namely January Admissions and July Admissions. Similarly, examinations are also conducted twice namely December TEE and June TEE.

After admissions are confirmed, your ID cards are to be downloaded. Your study materials will be sent to your mailing address given at the time of admissions.

Evaluation in IGNOU is done through Assignments (25-30%) and Term End Examinations (Theory and Practicals). Learners should submit one assignment for each course.

The question paper for each assignment can be downloaded from the IGNOU website (www.ignou.ac.in) and should be submitted handwritten in A4size papers indicating all your details and the respective question paper for evaluation at your study centre.

Every Learner has to take re-registration(an online process of filling a form and paying fees into the next year/semester of the programme) for due continuation of the programme into the next year without break.

All learners are advised to use the IGNOU student App to be updated with all the developments with their studies and for downloading study materials online.

Learners are also advised to access e-gyandarshn, Gyandarshan channel of IGNOY and all the Swayamprabha channels of IGNOU to view video lectures both live and recorded. You are also advised to listen to IGNOU Podcast, view press releases etc to get updated information on all IGNOU activities.

Once you receive the study materials check for the complete materials and then start preparing with your programme systematically and complete the programme within the minimum stipulated time.

All the mandatory compulsory components of your study including practicals, projects, field work practicum, ECP, workshops/seminars, viva-voce etc has to be completed on time for successful completion of your programme.

The services rendered at Regional Centre Port Blair include issue of duplicate ID card, migration certificate, course completion certificate, name correction, change of address, change of Regional Centre/Study centre, change of course/electives etc.

Once the learner completes the programme in all respects, the marksheet and provisional certificate will be sent to your address given at the time of admission from the Student Evaluation Division, IGNOU, New Delhi. Original degree certificates will be given during the convocation.
